Interpraevent2026 Submission Guidelines for Full Paper

1. Purpose and Scope

Interpraevent2026 aims to share the latest research results and insights related to natural disasters, debris

flows, and disaster engineering. These guidelines specify requirements for submitting papers (hereafter

referred to as "papers") to Interpraevent2026. The paper will be published as a special issue of the

"International Journal of Erosion Control Engineering", which is international journal organized by

Japanese Society of Erosion Control Engineering.

2. Eligible Submissions

Papers should report novel academic or technical findings and case studies relevant to the main topics of

Interpraevent2026 (e.g., sediment movement monitoring/modeling, disaster phenomena and

countermeasures, structural/non-structural measures, risk assessment, resilience, etc.).

Only previously unpublished original papers are acceptable.

Papers that have already been published or are under review (including in the review process) in other

journals or by other academic organizations cannot be submitted (no duplicate submissions).

3. Submission Language

The official submission language is English.

4. Paper Types and Structure

Full Paper: A manuscript detailing complete academic research or a comprehensive research report.

Example Structure:

Title

Authors and Affiliation

Abstract / Keywords

Main Text (Introduction, Methodology, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, etc.)

Acknowledgments (if necessary)

References

5. Recommended Length

Full Paper: Approximately 5–8 pages (A4 or in the prescribed format).

Please organize and balance figures, tables, and photos appropriately for clarity.

6. Manuscript Preparation Guidelines

Format: Follow the Word template provided by the organizers.

Figures and Tables:

Embed figures and tables in the text with clear captions (figure/table number and description).

Ensure resolution is sufficient for both print and digital distribution (recommended 300 dpi or higher).

References:

Use a consistent referencing style (author-year or numbered), in accordance with standard academic practices.

When citing websites, include the URL and the date accessed.

Units and Terminology:

Use the International System of Units (SI units) wherever possible.

For abbreviations, spell out the full term upon first mention.

[NOTE]

Along with your full paper, please submit an abstract of no more than 1-2 pages. This abstract will be archived along with the other abstracts for Interprevent2026. Please refer to the Extended Abstract Guidelines and Format for the abstract format, and submit it in a Word file that is different from the full paper.

7. Copyright and Rights

Copyright Ownership: For accepted and published papers, copyrights are governed by the rules established by Japan Society of Erosion Control Engineering.

Prohibition of Third-Party Rights Infringement: Obtain proper permission for any reproduced or adapted figures, tables, or photos. Carefully ensure that no copyrights, portrait rights, or other rights of third parties are infringed.

8. Submission and Peer Review Process

Submission Method:

Submit your paper via the designated online submission system by the specified deadline.

Peer Review:

The Editorial Subcommittee will evaluate the appropriateness, academic contribution, and originality of each submission, and at least two experts will conduct the peer review.

Review outcomes will be communicated as a request for revision, acceptance, or rejection.

In the case of revisions, revised papers must be submitted by the specified deadline.

Final Decision and Publication:

The Editorial Subcommittee will make the final decision on publication based on the peer review results and any revisions.

Major revisions after acceptance are generally not permitted.

9. Publication Fees and Registration

There is no publication fee. However, if you have not registered to participate in Interpraevent2026, your paper may be withdrawn from publication. Please pay the registration fee in accordance with the Call for Papers and the official website instructions.

10. Ethical Standards

Authors must adhere to research integrity and ethics. Any misconduct (fabrication, falsification, plagiarism, etc.) is strictly prohibited.

If duplicate submission is discovered, the paper will be rejected or publication withdrawn, and future submissions may be restricted.

11. Personal Data Protection

Personal information (such as names, affiliations, and contact details) collected during submission will only be used for peer review, editing, and related administrative communications, and not for any other purpose.
